**COVID-19 Updates:** 

#### • British Columbians' COVID-19 efforts allow easing of restrictions

Provincial Health Officer Dr. Bonnie Henry announced on February 15th, the easing of COVID-19 restrictions while maintaining key protective measures to support the health and safety of all British Columbians. While keeping the BC Vaccine Card, indoor masking requirements and COVID-19 safety plans in place, the provincial health officer will as of Wednesday, Feb. 16, 2022, at 11:59 p.m. (Pacific time) lift capacity limits for:

- o personal gatherings,
- o organized gatherings and events,
- o nightclubs, bars and restaurants,
- o exercise and fitness, and adult sports tournaments.

#### • Point of Care Risk Assessment - N95 masks

The BCCDC has updated the <u>Point of Care Risk Assessment</u> (PCRA) reference document to include scenarios where the donning of an N95 would be appropriate. In addition to wearing an N95 in areas where AGMPs may occur, the new guidance categorizes areas of elevated risk. A reminder that medical staff who are required to wear an N95 as part of their duties must be <u>fit tested</u> on an annual basis.
