

COVID-19 Updates:



• <u>Proof of Vaccination and mask rules still in place for hospitals</u>

Public events, services and businesses are no longer required to check for proof of vaccination, and indoor masking is no longer mandated, but these changes do not apply to healthcare facilities. Ambassadors will continue to screen visitors and proof of vaccination is still required for visitors entering acute care facilities (exceptions are made for compassionate care reasons such as emergency / critical care, end-of-life, pediatric care or labour and delivery). Masking is also still required.

• <u>Provincial Health Officer COVID-19 modeling update: April 5th</u>

The Provincial Health Officer April 5th, 2022 COVID-19 modeling update includes immunization data, cases, hospitalizations and deaths. As of April 8th BC's Vaccine Card is no longer required.

<u>B.C. shifts to weekly COVID-19 data reporting</u>
 Beginning Thursday April 7th, the Province has transitioned from daily to weekly
 (Thursday) COVID-19 reporting.

<u>Therapeutic Update | Operationalizing Remdesivir</u>

The BC CTC and CTRAWG recommend that remdesivir be used as the first-line alternative IV treatment if nirmatrelvir-ritonavir (PAXLOVID) cannot be prescribed.
