
COVID-19 Entrance Screening Tool for Health-Care Facilities (For all staff, visitors and patients/clients/residents)

This tool is for screeners at health-care facility entrances to determine whether an individual poses a COVID-19 risk and whether they should be permitted to enter. This tool should be used in accordance with the provincial visitor policy as well as any employer workplace health and safety (WHS) policies. This tool is an example that can be adapted based on setting and specific services and is not intended to replace medical advice. Follow the arrows to use this tool (e.g., if the answer to Question 1 is "Yes", the other questions do not need to be answered).





All persons entering a health-care facility must wear a mask in accordance with the **Provincial Mask Use in Health Care Settings Policy.**

Individuals with symptoms compatible with COVID-19 that are NOT permitted to enter should be directed to call 8-1-1 or their health-care provider or public health unit for assessment.
