What is "Surgical Renewal"?

On May 7, 2020, the Provincial Government announced the provincial surgical renewal plan. The immediate goal is to ensure that all health authorities recover from procedures lost during the COVID-19 pandemic. An expanded schedule and reduction of summer closures is increasing capacity presently and in the future. This is to ensure Island Health is able to meet our immediate patient requirements by rapidly rescheduling cancelled surgeries and preparing for population growth.

Reduce & Remove Summer Slowdown	 Reduce summer closures by an additional 210 hours 	 July 1, 2020 – September 7, 2020
