HOW WE ARE KEEPING YOU SAFE

- Frequent cleaning and infection prevention and control measures in between clients
- Wearing personal protective equipment as recommended by Worksafe BC and the BC Centre for Disease Control
- Pre-screening clients and visitors for COVID-19 to determine how to best support them safely
- Reconfiguring waiting and seating areas to support physical distancing
- Promoting hand hygiene practices
- Supporting care settings that are culturally safe and free of racism, discrimination and stigma

HOW YOU CAN HELP

- Please do not visit if you have a cough, fever or flu symptoms, or are ill with diarrhea or vomiting
- Clean your hands using hand sanitizer or soap & water as you enter and leave the facility, a patient room, or unit
- Maintain a physical distance of 2-metres from others
- Use a protective face mask, gloves and other protective equipment when instructed by the healthcare team
- Help us keep patient areas clean by keeping personal belongings to a minimum
- Do not touch wound dressings, lines, tubes or medical equipment
