To get your results log into your Island Health MyHealth Patient Portal 24-48 hours after your test

- If you do not have a MyHealth account, please call 1.844.844.2219, Monday-Friday between 8:30 am-4:30 pm to have one created.
- If you are unable to access MyHealth Portal for any reason, please call the Island Health Lab Call Centre at 1.866.370.8355 Monday to Friday 7 am – 6 pm or Saturdays and stat holidays 8 am – 4 pm for verbal results.
- You will need to provide you PHN # so have it handy when you call.

Results for minors

- Anyone under the age of 19 cannot be enrolled in the MyHealth Patient Portal.
- Results for youth ages 13 18 yrs. can <u>ONLY</u> be given directly to them. This is in accordance with the Infants Act.
- Youth can call 1.866.370.8355 themselves, or if a parent calls, the youth must be present to give verbal
 consent for results to be released to the parent. They will need to provide their PHN # so have it handy.

While waiting for your results . . .

- If you have not started already, make a list of people you have been in contact with since 2 days (48 hours) before you began experiencing symptoms.
 - Your contact list should include each person's name and the best phone number to reach them. If your test comes back positive, the nurse will ask you for the list.
