### **COVID-19 Patient ID and Assessement for Primary Care with MD/NP**

1 IDENTIFY

### **Patient reports:**

Fever, new cough, or difficulty breathing

Give patient and accompanying person(s) a mask to wear and ask to perform hand hygiene

2 ISOLATE

- Place patient in an separate room/area
- Implement Contact And Droplet Precautions
- Put on appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

3 ASSESS

**HISTORY - VITALS - RESP EXAM** 

Collect specimen<sup>1</sup>

4 DISPOSITION Requires Hospitalization: Call ED to notify sending patient


**Returning home:** provide patient handout<sup>1</sup> and advise patient to limit contact with others and call 811 if symptoms worsen

Clean and disinfect surfaces touched by patient and accompanying person(s)
