### Checklist

<b>Applies to:</b>	All <b>Retired Medical Practitioners</b> who are supporting the COVID-19 immunization clinics.
<b>Purpose:</b>	To ensure all Pandemic Immunizers are able to safely administer COVID-19 vaccines and are comfortable discussing concerns/misconceptions/questions that clients may have.

1. Print a copy of this document and check the boxes as you complete/review each item.
2. Bring your checklist to your first clinic shift.

**Note:** The [Provincial Health Officer \(PHO\) Orders on March 24<sup>th</sup>](#) require that Retired Medical Practitioners “must be supervised by a registrant who is authorized under a health profession regulation, and competent, to perform the Immunization Activity”. Please ensure you let the clinic lead know if you require supervision.
