



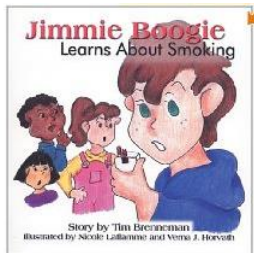

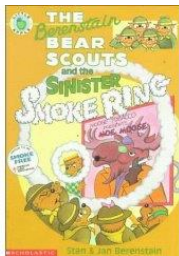


**Jimmie Boogie Learns About Smoking**

Target: grades K-3

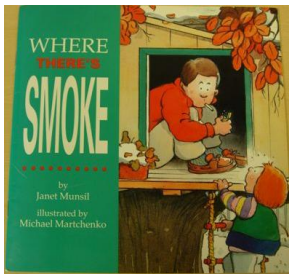


**The Berenstain Bear Scouts and the Sinister Smoke Ring**

Target: grade 3 – 5

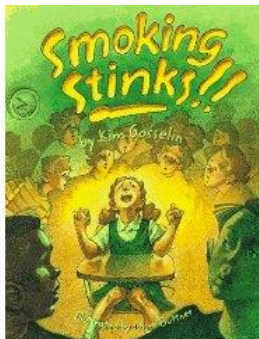


**Where There's Smoke**

Target: grade K-3

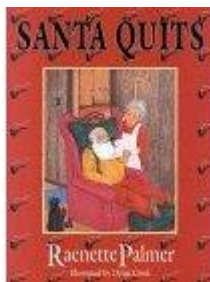


**Smoking Stinks**

Target: grade 3 – 5

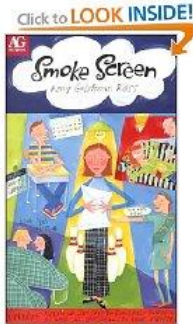


**Santa Quits**
