## Right From The Start Prenatal Registration:

Please register with **Right From The Start Prenatal Registration**; Island Health's universal prenatal registration, at https://surveys.viha.ca/Checkbox/RFTSRegistration.aspx

Registration can also be done in person at the Comox Valley Public Health Nursing office (961 England Avenue, Courtenay), at doctor's offices or midwifery offices.
