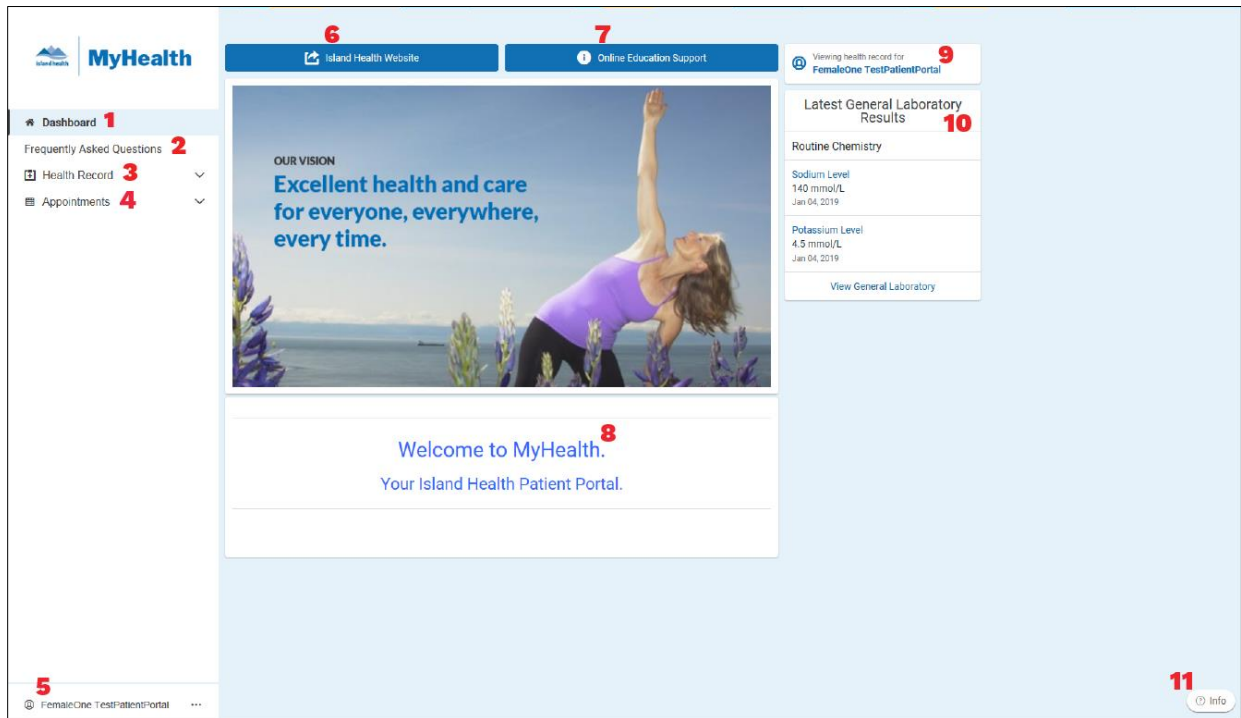


**MyHealth**

<b>Purpose:</b>	To learn how to set up and use the MyHealth patient portal account.

## MyHealth Overview

When you log into the MyHealth patient portal, links to all of your MyHealth account information appear in the **Dashboard**. There are also links to help you find more information about MyHealth and other relevant services.



<b>1. Dashboard</b>	Your MyHealth home page; where your personal account information appears.
<b>2. Frequently Asked Questions</b>	Click to read answers to common questions about MyHealth.
<b>3. Health Record</b>	Click to see your Laboratory results and Imaging reports.
<b>4. Appointments</b>	Click to see your scheduled appointments.
<b>5. Account Management</b>	Shows the name of the person who is logged in to MyHealth. Click the ellipsis (...) to see your account details. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Account</b> is where you can update your name within MyHealth, your log in email address, or your MyHealth password</li> <li>• <b>Notifications</b> is where you can update your email address (notifications from MyHealth are sent to this email address).</li> <li>• <b>Access Logs</b> is where you can see when you previously logged in to MyHealth.</li> <li>• <b>Help</b> gives you the MyHealth Help Desk number and examples of when you should call for help regarding your MyHealth account.</li> </ul>

<b>7. Online Education Support</b>	Click to go to HealthLinkBC, where you can find non-emergency health information.
<b>8. Welcome to MyHealth</b>	Displays general Island Health messages about MyHealth.
<b>9. Name</b>	Shows the name of the person whose MyHealth information you are viewing.
<b>10. Latest General Laboratory Results</b>	A list of your most recent laboratory results.
<b>11. Info</b>	<p>Click to get your Support ID.</p> <p><b>Note:</b> You need your Support ID if you call the MyHealth Help Desk for technical support.</p> <p>You can also see the most current <i>Terms of Use</i> and <i>Privacy Policy</i> by clicking <b>Info</b>.</p>
